Step 1: If you haven't made an appointment as yet) make one with NSW Health for a local vaccine hub or for participating General Practitioners (GP), clinics or pharmacies.

Step 3: Get Vaccinated! And book your second dose at the same time, to insure you get the full benefit out of the vaccinations.

Our drivers and passengers wear masks, and adhere to strict policies regarding COVID-19 safe cleaning and infection control measures.

Transport costs

We are operating these transports for you at the subsidised rate of \$10.00 per return trip to a medical facility to enable you to have your COVID immunisation. This price is only available to clients travelling within the bounds of their local government areas.
